Up to 250 schools districtwide could face the same threat of takeover in coming years. Let's send a message NOW that we won't let our schools be given away. Besides the harm the give-aways will do to student learning, the loss of schools could ultimately mean the loss of salary, jobs, health care, and retirement benefits for all of us.
