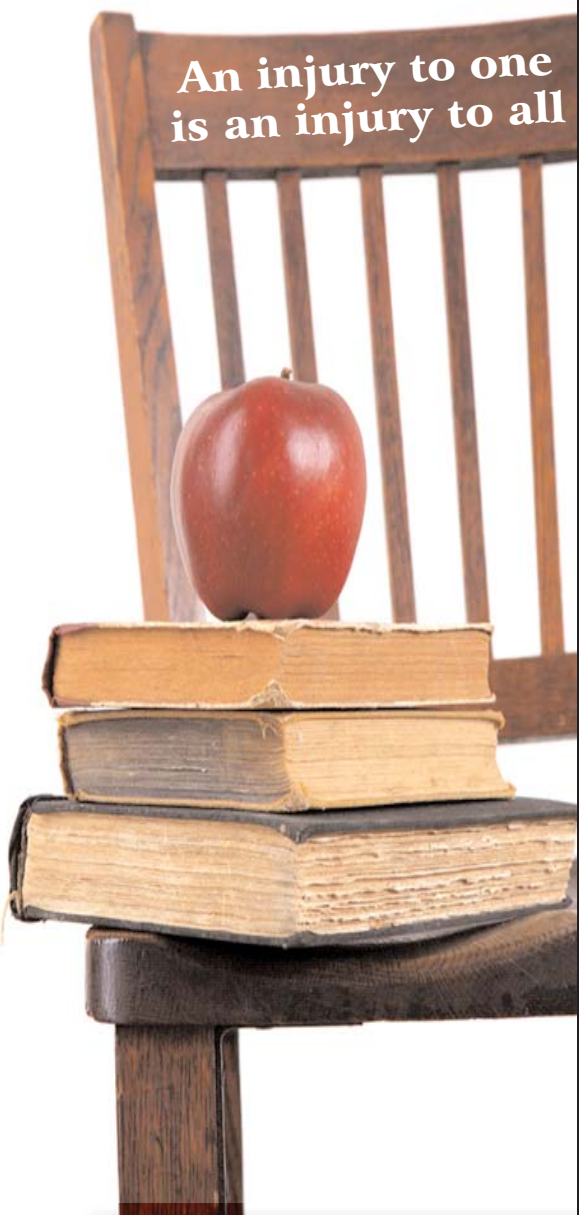


Empty chairs = higher class size = lower quality education
