Sue Embrey, educator, activist and author, lived by her principles of non-violence, self-determination through unionization, social justice for workers, teamwork, collaboration, service to others, and empowerment of the disenfranchised.

Sue Embrey is most recognized for her work education the public about the injustices of the internment of the Japanese Americans during World War II. In 1969 she helped to organize the first Manzanar Pilgrimage and also co-founded the Manzanar Committee that worked to gain designation of Manzanar as a California State Historic Landmark and eventually a National Historic Site.
