Governor Schwarzenegger released his January state budget proposal with another \$2 billion in cuts, two days after promising he would protect public education from further harm! Who does he think he is fooling?

The governor and the state Legislature have cut the budget for public education by \$18 billion in two years, resulting in thousands of layoffs of K-12 teachers and other school employees. Class sizes are soaring. The school year has been cut back and summer sessions eliminated. Thousands of college instructors have lost jobs and tens of thousands of eligible students have been denied admission. University fee increases are pricing working families out of higher education.

This was not inevitable. *This was a choice.* On January 26, to protect public education and other vital social services from further devastation, the people of Oregon passed two ballot measures that raised taxes on the very rich and the corporations. If it can happen in Oregon it can happen here. *It's a question of priorities. Enough is enough!*

- **Contact your school board and tell them "No layoffs or class size increases"**
