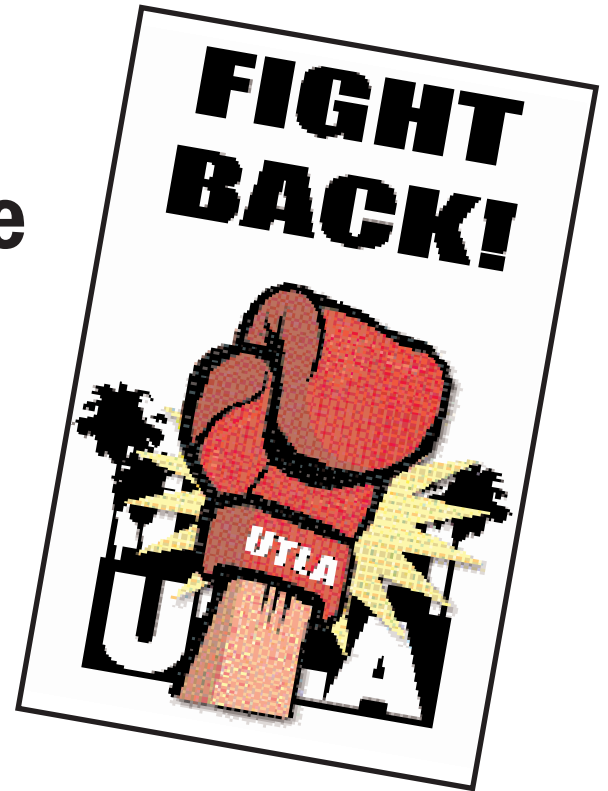




UTLA members to take strike authorization vote March 20-25



Building on the momentum of our massive rally on January 29, UTLA members will be taking our fight to the next level with a strike authorization vote March 20-25.

We are at a critical juncture in both contract talks and health care negotiations.

A YES vote means you support our contract demands for no health care cuts, safer schools, and a stronger teacher voice on assessments and professional development.

A YES vote will empower our negotiating team and send an undeniable message to the District that we're ready to take action if necessary.

A strike will not result directly from this vote; a second vote would be held on the District's "last, best" offer before a strike could be called.

UTLA continues to fight on all fronts—in contract talks and beyond—to stop layoffs, class-size increases, health care cuts, and excessive one-size-fits-all testing.
