UTLA took over the streets of El Segundo demanding VOTERS support PROP 15. GALIC members drove through the streets honking horns with PRO 15 signs plastered to their cars. They stood on main thoroughfares with signs asking voters to “**FUND THE STUDENTS**”. Chevron is head quartered in El Segundo, and was the enemy of updating Prop 13. Corporations must pay their fair share! Residents were supportive and many didnt know that California still ranks at the bottom for Public School Funding. Although PROP 15 failed, due to corporate manipulation, this needed action brought visibility and educators to the streets.
