

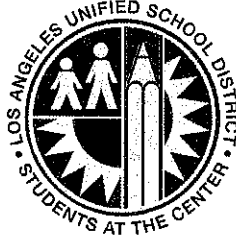
DRAFT DISTRICT PROPOSAL (OUTLINE)
MOU BETWEEN LAUSD & UTLA FOR 2020-2021 REOPENER AGREEMENT
AUGUST 23, 2021

The District will provide:

- A. A 4% across the board increase on all schedules to UTLA bargaining unit members effective July 1, 2021.
- B. A \$500 technology stipend to all UTLA Bargaining Unit members.
- C. A \$1,000 lump-sum payment to all regular classroom teachers in pre-K-12 and Adult Education.

UTLA agrees to:

- A. Acknowledgement and recognition of the attached August 24, 2021 Continuity of Learning/Quarantine Plan including completion of any effects bargaining.
- B. Allow the District the flexibility to temporarily assign teachers previously exempted from displacement to the City of Angels Online Independent Study program as needed, and in the spirit of following students.
 - i. To the extent possible, and in alignment with student and program needs, volunteers will be sought before making any temporary assignments of teachers previously exempted from displacement
 - ii. All teachers temporarily assigned to teach at City of Angels under this agreement shall have the right to return to their previous school location at the beginning of the 2022-2023 school year, with displacement rights if necessary.
 - iii. In the case of a voluntary assignment to City of Angels of a teacher other than one previously exempted from displacement, a teacher previously exempted from displacement at the school site would fill any temporary vacancy created at the sending school.
- C. Flexibility to implement “school-based” online instructional programs, as allowable by law, through Edgenuity or a similar online program, with school-based teaching staff monitoring student progress.

Los Angeles Unified is committed to ***every student receiving high-quality and standards-aligned instruction throughout the 2021-2022 school year***. The following guidance is provided to ensure continuity of instruction and learning for all students in the event of COVID-19-related absences and/or other emergencies or natural disasters that may result in disruption of in-person instruction.

In the case of a natural disaster, such as a fire, or other emergency that causes a school closure affected individuals assigned to home will remain at home until the end of the closure or until they are instructed to return. The same would occur in case of whole-classroom closure due to quarantine.

The plans that follow provide an outline of how instruction is to be delivered to students in Pre-K through Adult Education under 4 different circumstances, whether provided as short-term independent study or during an excused absence:

1. Whole class, including teacher, is quarantined
2. School is closed due to natural disaster/emergency
3. Teacher is present but one or more students are quarantined
4. Teacher and possibly one or more students are quarantined, but other students are present in school with a substitute
