## Our Spring 2018 Action Plan

3. Organize parent involvement through area forums and actions in February and March, along with the Reclaim Our Schools LA coalition.
4. Collect the signatures necessary to qualify the *Make It Fair* ballot initiative that will raise \$11 billion in state revenue and ensure increased education funding.
5. Phone bank, precinct walk and organize to beat privatizers like Antonio Villaraigosa and Marshall Tuck at the ballot box.

## We Must Radically Shift Educational Priorities
